There are two treatments for so-cial anxiety that seem to help: medi-cation and counseling. There are an-tianxiety medications that work to lessen the anxiety symptoms. There is a beta-blocker (propranolo)! that is sobmetimes helpful for performers who have "stage fright." Some anti-depressants have been shown it be effective in helping arrisety. Pacil is the one antidepressant that has been approved by the Food and Drug Ad-

ful in treating the anxiety.

Counseling is also helpful in treating anxiety, particularly a kind of counseling called Cognitive Therapy.

Cognitive Therapy works to change the thought processes that cause the anxiety. Lisa, who has trouble talking to men her age, does not even realize, what she is telling herself to cause the anxiety.
