

Conservation District holds Art/Writing Contest banquet



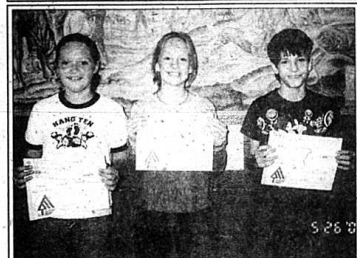
