David Blair Williams, 45, of Berea and Olive Hill, died Sunday, July 15, 2001 in Grayson. David was born July 25, 1955 in Covington, the son of Allen Jr. and Mary Ann Blair Williams.

He was a class of 75 graduate of the Cincinnati College of Mortuary Science, a licensed funeral director/embalmer and the owner of Williams Funeral Home of Berea and Carter County Funeral Home in Olive Hill. An avid sponsor of local softball teams and a loyal supporter of numerous civic organizations, David was always there to help those in need. He was an active member of several local lodges and clubs including the R. H. 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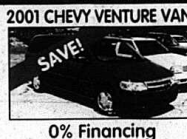
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
