NOTICE OF INTENT

The Western Rockcastle Water Association intends to file an application with USDA Rural utility Service (RUS) and the Appalachian Regional Commission (ARC) for funding for the Water System Extensions & Improvements Project - Contract 6. The project entails the construction of 61,500 LF of 4-inch and 3-inch water line to serve 71 new customers in various areas of Rockcastle and Pulaski Counties. Project also includes 10,000 LF of 8-inch transmission main and a new booster pump station and telemetry system to upgrade service to several hundred existing customers. Project will request RUS Loan and Grant funds and ARC funds.
