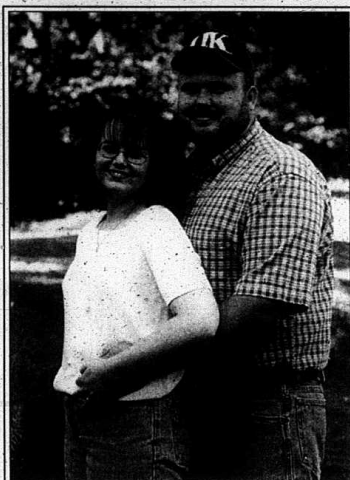
Bertram - Arnold wed

After honeymoon in the Smokies the couple returned to Livingston to make their home.

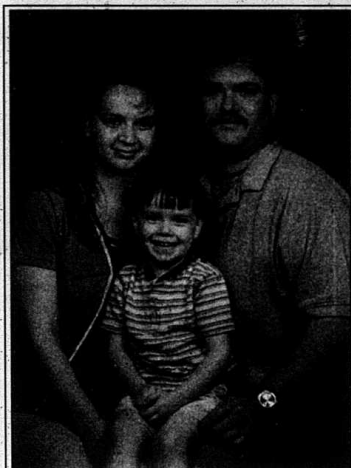
Carolyn is the daughter of Dee and Justen Bertram of Monticello. Jackie is the son of Sally Mae and the late John Arnold, both of Livingston.

The church was chosen for the wedding in honor of the groom's parents, Lonnie and Vickie Anglin. They were married there 29 years ago on May 28, 1972.

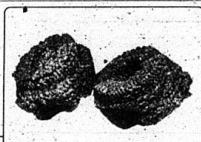
After a wonderful honeymoon of one week at Lake Cumberland Resort Park in Jamestown, the couple resides in Quail Community of Rockcastle County.
