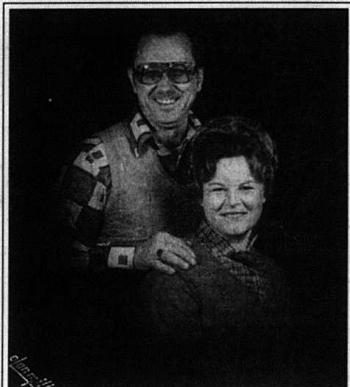




61st Wedding Anniversary

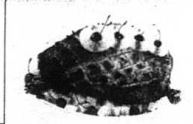

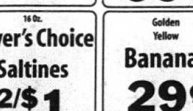

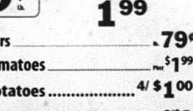
