Paul understood that there are crimes and deeds that are worthy of death. The idea being, of "balancing out" the crime with the punishment. God has ordained that civil government with this duty, Rom 13:1-4. Now is it not our choice to carry out a vigil anti justice, but government can and should punish evil doers. This will create fear into the hearts of people that this is what "crime pays".
