

Boys defeat Williamsburg and Madison Southern

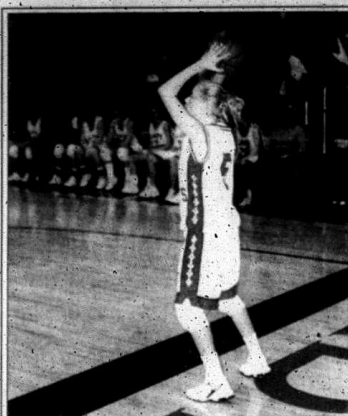
The RCHS boys basketball team have added two more to their win column by defeating Williamsburg last Friday night and Madison Southern Tuesday night.

Last Friday night at Williamsburg, the boys took a commanding 26-12 first quarter lead and never looked back in their 78-56 win.

Aaron Cash and Jason Reynolds tied for scoring honors for the Rockets with 25 each; Austin Miller got 11, Andrew Hammond 10, Aaron Anderson 9 and Stephen Boring, Chris Settles and Blake Roberts, 2 each.

Tuesday night, the Rockets were cruising to an easy win over the Madison Southern Eagles but almost got derailed in the closing minutes of the game. After leading 62-42 early in the fourth quarter, the Rockets went cold and the Eagles didn't outscore the Rockets 20-5 to pull within five points before Chris Settles got a 4 for 4 front the free throw line to keep the 71-62 win. Overall, the Rockets were 7 for 20 from the charity stripe.

Cash led the scoring for his team with 21; Hammond got 18; Reynolds 8; Anderson 7; Miller 6; Settles 4 and Devin Taylor 2.

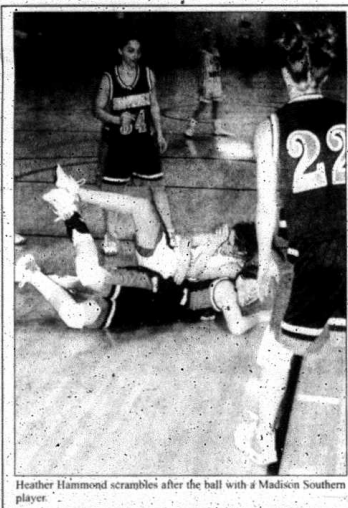
It was a heartbreaker Tuesday night as the game was very close the entire time. The Rockets were ahead

Rowe had 15 points to lead the Rockets in scoring; Abney got 13, Hayes, who fouled out in the closing minutes of the game, got 9; Hammond and Mink had 8 each and Denney 6.
