an exceptional effort of 2:51.8.
Sixth grader Morgan Thacker missed one of her AAU basketball games on Saturday to help her team. She competed very well in the long jump competition and finished 17th overall with an exceptional leap of 12'7".

The boys' team placed 16th overall out of twenty-two teams that competed. RCHS was led by senior Josh Hale who scored in both the 400 and 200-meter dashes. In the 400, Josh finished 5th overall with a spectacular time of 54.9 seconds. Josh competed in the 200-meter dash for the first time this season and ran an eye-shine race. He placed 3rd overall with an exceptional time of 2:42 seconds.

Sophomore Andrew Nelson ran a great 1600-meter race. Andrew, who broke the RCHS mile record at the Patriot Games last week, followed that performance with a solid 5:01.6. He finished 11th overall in the event. Teammate Brandon Cole ran well early in the race but could not finish, due to a leg cramp. In the 3200-meter run, Andrew broke the record set by Brandon a week earlier. He finished 8th overall with a new RCHS record

time of 10:53.7, an improvement of two-tenths of a second over Brandon's previous record time.

Sophomore Caleb Blair ran very well in the 100-meter dash. He finished 21st overall in 12.2 seconds. Caleb also ran the 400-meter dash for the first time. Despite the lack of practice for the event, Caleb managed an impressive 10th place finish in 55.9 seconds.

Coty Reams ran well in the 100-meter dash and finished 25th overall in 12.5 seconds. Teammate Josh Taylor ran a hard-fought 200-meter dash and finished 22nd overall in 28.8 seconds. Josh also competed in shot put and discus. In the shot put competition, Josh threw 304.25' and placed 31st overall. In the discus competition, Josh also threw well and placed 29th overall with an effort of 77'3".

Senior Andrew Hammond showed signs of fatigue from after basketball practice the night before; however, he still managed a solid performance in both long jump and high jump. In long jump, Andrew placed 16th overall with a leap of 16'11". In high jump, Andrew jumped an impressive 5'8" for a 7th place finish overall.

The RCHS track teams will next compete in the Heart of the Bluegrass meet in Harrodsburg this Saturday. More than thirty teams are scheduled to attend.

Dale Jr., Waltrip and Chevys Finish 1-2

TALLADEGA, Ala.—Dale Earnhardt Jr. led 133 laps of the 188 lap Aaron's 499 Winston Cup race, Sunday at Talladega, for his first win of the season.
He held off his Dale Earnhardt, Inc. teammate Michael Waltrip, and Roush Racing Ford driver Kurt Busch to also give Chevrolet their first victory of the year.

The race was red flagged on lap 182 so crews could clean up oil spilled from the No. 20 Pontiac of Tony Stewart.

When green flag racing resumed, there were only four laps remaining. Earnhardt got a good jump on Waltrip and the rest of the field. The cars of Busch, Jimmie Johnson, Dale Jarrett, Sterling Marlin, and Jeff Gordon tried to make a move to the front, but with Waltrip blocking, they were unable to pass.

Dale Jr. just had too many horses under the hood of his No. 8 Budweiser Chevrolet.

The usual "Big Wreck" occurred on lap 164 that involved 24 cars.

The accident appeared to happen when Mike Wallace's No. 33 bumped Stewart's No. 20, forcing him into the outside wall.

Bobby Labonte was one of the cars caught up in it.

"The '29' car got sideways," said Labonte. "I don't know what made him go sideways at first, but he was sideways. I think I clipped him in the right rear just a little bit which turned my car to the right, slid sideways and then it went back to the left."

"I got going straight and guys were still wrecking on the inside. The '19' car was just sliding and it ended up that I hit him after I kind of got straightened out. I believe I would

have been all right if that hadn't happened."

"I don't know whose fault it was. It's really nobody's fault. We're all here. We're all racing. It's just that we're all there in a position. You can't help it. When something like that happens, everybody is so close. I guess one good thing about it is everybody is going the same speed, so when they hit they really don't hit that hard."
