NOTICE OF SALE

Pursuant to a judgment and order of sale entered in this action on April 26, 2002, for the purpose of satisfying the judgment against the defendants in the amount of TWENTY EIGHT THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED NINETY TWO DOLLARS AND 15/100 (\$28,292.15), plus interest, costs and attorney fees, I will offer at public auction the hereinafter described real property in Rockcastle County, Kentucky.

At the Premises Located in Rockcastle County, Kentucky on Tuesday, May 28, 2002 Beginning at the Hour of 2:00 p.m.

Said property being more particularly bounded and described as follows:

Lot 5, No. 5, 6 and 7 in Block "D" of the Mount Vernon Fair Ground Addition to the City of Mt. Vernon, as shown on plat of subdivision, of record in Deed Book 47, page 103, in the office of the clerk of the Rockcastle County Court, Mt. Vernon, Kentucky. Reference is made to said plat for a more complete description of said lots.

There is excluded herefrom and not now conveyed that portion of Lot 5 which was sold by Clinton McClure to Roger Lovell, by deed dated January 24, 1981, recorded in the office of the clerk of the Rockcastle County Court in Deed Book 116, page 107.

Being the real property conveyed to Gene Evans and Margaret Evans (n/k/a Margaret E. Barnett) husband and wife, from Emmett McClure and Nellie McClure, husband and wife, by deed dated December 22, 1993 and recorded in Deed Book 152, page 447 in the office of the Rockcastle County Clerk. Gene Evans died on January 11, 1996. Margaret Evans (n/k/a Margaret Barnett), became the sole owner of the premises by virtue of the survivorship clause. Margaret Evans Barnett and Jeffrey Barnett, husband and wife, conveyed the subject real property to Joseph King and Angela King by land contract of record in Deed Book 178, page 392 in the office of the Rockcastle County Clerk.

The property shall be sold on the following terms and conditions:

- The real property shall be sold for cash or upon a credit of thirty (30) days with the purchaser required to pay a minimum of ten percent (10%) of the purchase price in cash on the date of sale and to secure the balance with a bond approved by the Master Commissioner.
- The bond shall bear interest at the rate of twelve percent (12%) per annum until paid in full. The bond shall have the force and effect of a judgment and shall be and remain a lien upon the property sold as additional surety for the payment of the purchase price.
- 2001 and all unpaid taxes of record at the time of entry of judgment shall be paid out of the proceeds of sale.
