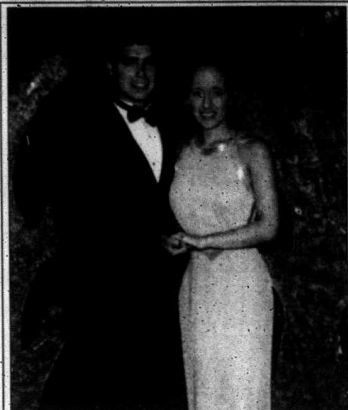
60th Wedding Anniversary
