I have been very honored to serve as your County Judge-Executive. When you elected me, you hired me to work for our county's collective benefit. I know when I travel on our roads I see the difference and progress we have made—from black-topped roads to waterline construction—our county has improved greatly. From the Tech Center at the courthouse to making cemetery roads passable—to helping assure that our school buses operate on roads that were once closed to them due to condemned bridges—all these things have made a difference, and I certainly know that we have a lot more to do to help Rockcastle County.

Building Bridges Between The County Fiscal Court and Brodhead, Livingston and Mt. Vernon

Never before has the county worked so closely with the city councils of these three towns. The county has helped supply funds to place trees on Brodhead's Main Street, provided space for the Livingston City Hall, and, during declared emergencies, helped those cities that called me with snow removal. In addition, the Fiscal Court is working very closely with the City of Mt. Vernon and the Rockcastle Water Association to construct waterlines to residences who need public water service. We do these things by working together.

County's Finances

I personally know there has been a great leap forward in our county's financial capabilities. When I first got into office, our abilities were so limited and constricted, we, frankly, couldn't do much to help you. When our county decided to rebuild the jail, it opened a new opportunity to bring in over \$55,000 every month into our county. In addition to providing jobs, it also made it possible to meet our financial obligations.

Only last week a state official was in my office when he commented our county's finances are now in much better shape.

Community Involvement

There has been a great and important surge in community involvement—from private service organizations to quasi-governmental agencies.

The Rockcastle County Development Board, under the direction of Bigge Towery and the board members, have worked tirelessly with local businesses, Rep. Danny Ford and Congressman Hal Rogers and individuals to construct the state's first telecommunications center at the Rockcastle Courthouse. The Fiscal Court provided the 2,000 sq. ft. space, and the county entered into an agreement with the Rockcastle County School Board whereby the local schools operate the facility. Rockcastle's facility was the only one used on a statewide brochure.

In addition, the Development Board has held many long meetings to assure that Rockcastle County has a comprehensive, long-range plan of development for our communities.

New Actions in Rockcastle

Among many other things, we now have a jail work release program to help with our road work, cemetery roads, litter and dump sites. This would not have been possible without the county's Fiscal Court involvement.

As your County Judge-Executive, I have made every effort to make all of our roads better—including the cemetery roads. I remember when, as a 12-year-old boy, I had to help push a hearse through mud to bury my great grandfather. This made a lasting impression upon me, which is why I have never apologized to anyone for making roads better. If re-elected, I will continue working to make all our roads better, and I know there is much more to get done.

Countywide Improvements
