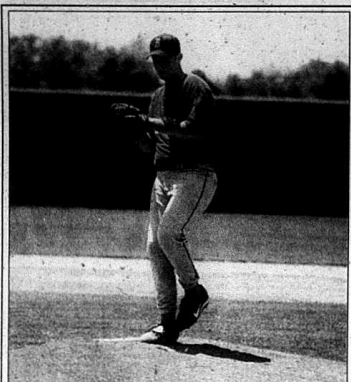

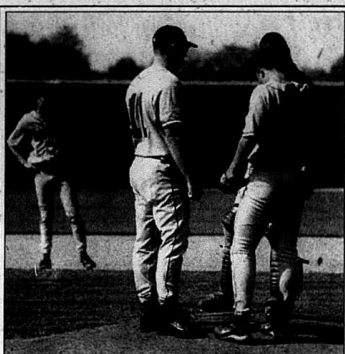
This years illusionist Roger Despard will be attempting Harry Houdini's death defying milk can escape, plus many of the exciting illusions seen on national television.

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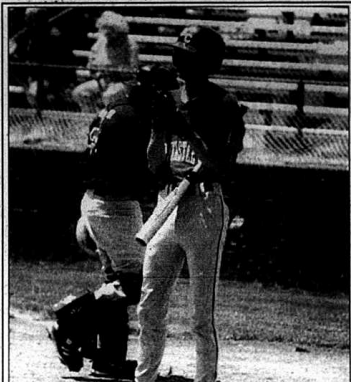
