This is National Hospital Week and Rockcastle Health and Rehabilitation Center is honoring employees for the valuable contribution they make in providing quality healthcare to the community.

nation and is today the nation's largest healthcare event, according to the American Hospital Association. This year's theme is Where Miracles Happen.

Rockcastle Health and Rehabilitation Center, Inc. is a not-for-profit community hospital, which is accredited by the Joint Commission on Accreditation of Healthcare Organizations (JCAHO). It operates inpatient and outpatient acute care programs, 60 long-term beds for ventilator-dependent patients, and a home health care service. The organization recently purchased a local nursing home, which has been renamed Rockcastle Health and Rehabilitation Center, Inc. It will be surveyed by JCAHO later this year.
