There are many families who will tell you that hey once thought the same thing. Unfortunately they were wrong.

A conference on suicide prevention was held last year in October. The recommendations of this conference are being taken very seriously by the surgeon general. They recommended the following:

1,1 Educating the public that suicide is preventiable and working to diminish the stigma of mental filmes, substance abuse and suicide.

2. Working with news and entertainment media to present balanced portrayals of suicide.

3. Increasing research on suicide risk and prevention programs.
