City of Mt. Vernon, Kentucky Ordinance No. 2-2002

AN ORDINANCE ENACTING AND ADOPTING A SUPPLEMENT TO THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF MT. VERNON, KENTUCKY.

WHEREAS, Burlington Publishing Systems, Florence, Kentucky, has completed the 2001 S-13 Supplement to the Code of Ordinances of the City of Mt. Vernon, which supplement contains all ordinances of a general nature enacted since the adoption of the Supplement S12 of this municipality; and

WHEREAS, said Burlington Publishing Systems has recommended the revision or addition of certain sections of the Code of Ordinances which are based on or make references to sections of the Kentucky code; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of Council to accept these updated sections in accordance with the changes of the law of the Commonwealth of Kentucky;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Mt. Vernon, Commonwealth of Kentucky:

SECTION 1: That the 2001 S-13 Supplement to the Code of Ordinances of the City of Mt. Vernon, as submitted by Burlington Publishing Systems, and as attached hereto, be and the same is hereby adopted by reference as if set out in its entirety.

SECTION 2: That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its date of passage.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF ROCKCASTLE COUNTY, KENTUCKY:

WHEREAS, the proposed budget was tentatively approved by the fiscal court on the 29th day of May, 2002 and approved as to form and classification by the State Local Finance Officer on the 12th day of June, 2002.
