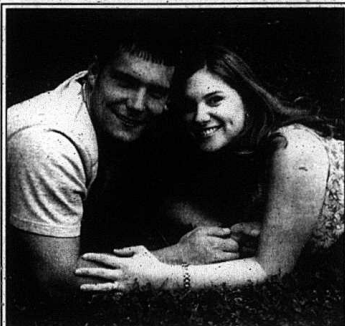

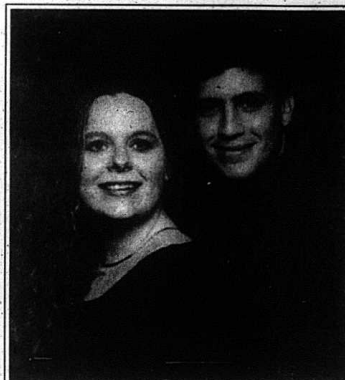
Miller - Rodgers

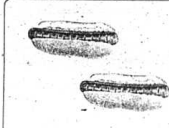
