The Joint Commission on Accreditation of Healthcare Organiza tions will conduct an accreditation survey of Rockcastle Hospital and Respiratory Care Center on August 26 - 30, 2002.

The purpose of this survey will be to evaluate the organization's compliance with nationally established Joint Commission standards. The survey results will be used to determine whether, and the conditions under which accreditation should be awarded the

organization.

Joint Commission standards deal with organizational quality and safety of care issues and the safety of the environment in which care is provided. Anyone believing that he or she has perfinent and valid information about such matters may request a public information interview with the Joint Commission's filed representatives at the time of the survey, Information presented at the interview will be carefully evaluated for relevance to the accreditation process. Requests for a public information interview must be made in writing and should be sent to the Joint Commission no later than five working days before the survey begins. The request must also indicate the nature of the information to be provided at the interview. Such requests should be addressed to:

Division of Accreditation Operations

The Joint Commission's Office of Quality Monitoring will acknowledge in writing or by telephone requests received 10 days before the survey, begins. An Account Representative will contact the individual requesting the publication information interview prior to survey, indicating the location, date and time of the interview and the name of the surveyor who will conduct the interview.
