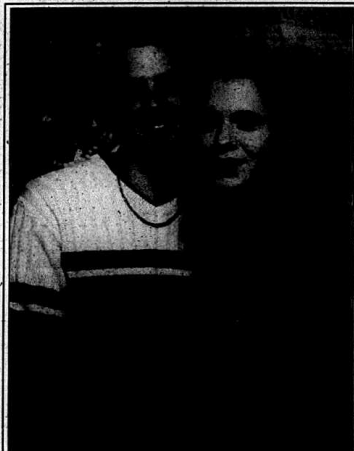

Pursuant to an amended judgment and order of sale entered in this action on July 26, 2002, for the purpose of satisfying the judgment against the defendants in the amount of ONE HUNDRED THIRTY SEVEN THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED THIRTY ONE DOLLARS AND 13/100 (\$137,731.13), plus interest, costs and attorney fees. I will offer at public auction the hereinafter described real property in Rockcastle County, Kentucky.
