

Team Mission USA volunteer at Outreach

Two mission teams, one from Central Church of Christ in Findlay, Ohio and another from South Jefferson Christian Church in Louisville, joined forces July 30-August 1 to work at Christ's Outreach for the Blind in Mt. Vernon. Christ's Outreach, a non-profit, Christian-based camp for blind and disabled campers, has hosted mission teams from several different states this summer to help in the construction phase of the project.

Teen Mission, USA, an organization that plans mission trips for teens throughout the nation, helped organize the trip which was coordinated locally by Cori Brewster, 24, Teen Mission, USA has a mission statement with a primary purpose that is two-fold, to encourage spiritual growth in American Christians in their personal and working relationship with God through genuine commitment and "hands-on" experience and to provide American Christians opportunities to see the larger world picture God sees, as they experience Him using their testimony to lead

others to a saving relationship with Jesus.

"Working with Christ's Outreach for the Blind and Disabled has been exciting and encouraged me," said Mike Sheley, 25, Minister of Children and Youth at South Jefferson Christian Church in Louisville. "Hearing Mike Gates' testimony of the story behind this ministry and seeing our students working with others from Ohio has shown me just how active God is in this world and in the lives of teenagers," he said.

Besides their imprint on the camp from many hours of labor, the youth volunteers left written testimonies of their mission experience at Christ's Outreach. "I am learning about life firsthand when working 7-9 hours straight, but this is for God. Though I may not always like it, I remind myself that this is for the Lord and the blind children," said Jeremy Mills, 15. Another young volunteer, Erin Troyer, 15, said, "God is continually stretching me each day, but I know it is good for me."

The mission teams stayed at Ken-

tucky Christian Assembly Camp in Brodhead during their trip and to hold a three-night Vacation Bible School at Livingston Christian Church. Their work at Christ's Outreach for the Blind included finishing walls for the center, laying liner for a large pond, setting rocks for a fountain and cleaning, scraping and

sanding metal beds that will be used for campers.

Mike Gates and his wife, Lori, Directors of Christ's Outreach, have coordinated the work of scores of mission volunteers this summer. "This mission group was awesome," Gates said. "They even found their

own lodging. In today's society where many people don't want to work, every kid brought in a donation of \$100 plus their labor."

When Christ's Outreach for the Blind officially opens, it will accommodate 600 campers per year. Camp-

ing activities will include horseback riding, hunting, fishing, swimming, mountain climbing, hiking, rappelling, gardening and independent living skills. For more information about this camp for the blind and disabled, please call Mike Gates at 1-888-254-6319.
