Apple Growers Assistance Program

The U.S. Department of Agriculture amounced signup for the 2000 Apple Market Loss Assistance Program (AMLAP-II) will provide payment to help offset economic losses due to low prices in the US apple market. Torwers will receive a payment per pound for their 2000 crop apple production, and they will be paid on a maximum of 5 million, pounds per separate apple operation.

To receive cash payments, eligible apple producers must.

1. have produced apples during

any program authorized under the ACT for the 2003 crop year.
Grantors must file the FSA 211 dated 7-25-02 to appoint an attorney-in-fact to act on their behalf for FSA and CCC programs.
