Smith's passenger, Gregory Thomas, 18, of Livingston, was not injured in the wreck.

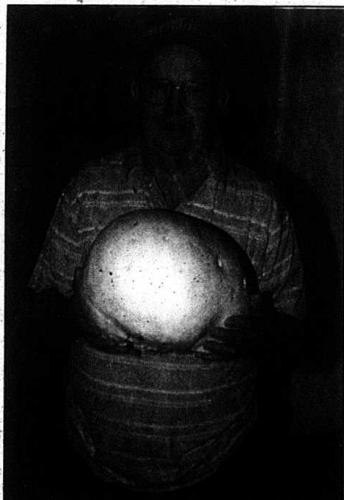
