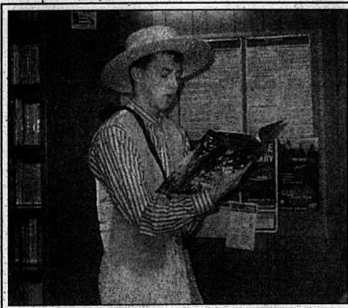
Thanks so much for all of the things you do to help us here at the Rockcastle County Public Library! Working together works!

We are planning to have a Halloween Party for the children here at the library from 4 until 5 p.m. Halloween

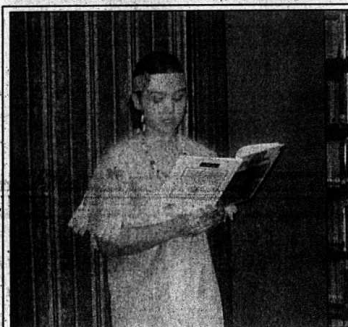

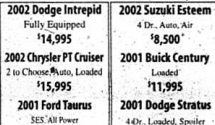

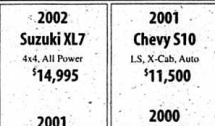
