at the camp.

Work and fellowship abounded and projects. One might be skeptical and wonder what could be completed in such a short period of time. Well, drywall was hung in the office. Several bedrooms and beds were painted. Shelves were built in storage spaces. Chair cushions that had been reupholstered at the beginning of spring were reassembled with the chairs. Just like the summer work groups, Christ's Outreach for the Blind was

changed when this group left.

Unlike those summer groups that had visited this camp for blind and physically handicap children, this

one was different. It was mainly an adult work group with all participants but two ranging in age from 29 to 78 years old. Another interesting fact about this group, it contained members from two churches. Andrea Smith from Turner Baptist Church was so inspiring when she said, "For the last several years, I have gone on mission trips with my church, but this year I was not able to go with them because of the distance. So when I heard that Falmouth Baptist was going to this camp, I decided to come along with them."

Mission work is all over the world. People are in need. Mission work is even here in Rockcastle County. As Billy Arnold from this group wrote, "When you think you have problems, all you have to do is look around, and there are people with a lot worse problems."
