For sending us Chad Burdette.

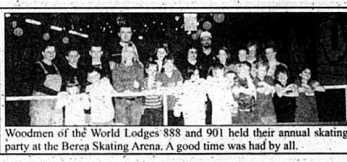

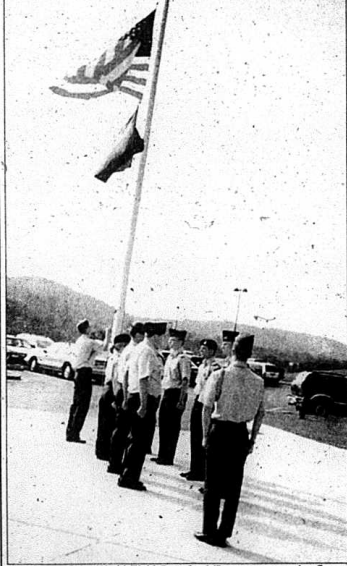
Woodmen of the World Field Rep. Jean Towery presented a flag to Jack Hayes, past president of Antique Farm Machinery Show at Rentfro Valley.
