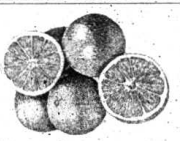
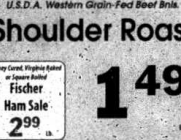
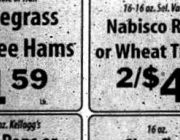
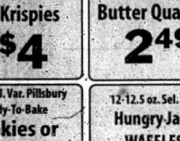
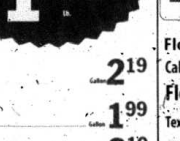
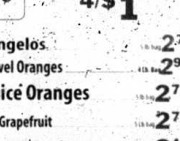
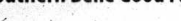
Broyles-Ponder
