As part of the National Diabetes Month in November, the Cabinet for Health Services wants Kentuckians with diabetes to know they are at high risk for having a heart attack or stroke.

You can help to lower your risk by managing the ABCs of diabetes. A is for AIC, a test measures aver-age blood glucose (blood segar) over the past two to three months. B is for blood-pressure and C is for holes-terol. re and C is for chol

The Kentucky Diabetes Cor and Prevention Program and the Ken-tucky Diabetes Network have joined with the National Diabetes Education Program (NDEP), the American Dia-betes Association and the American College of Cardiology to urge the 17 million people with diabetes to man-

age their blood pressure and choles-terol, along with their blood glucose terol, along with their blood glucose to help prevent heart attack and stroke-the leading killers of people with diabetes. New studies show a strong link between diabetes and heart disease and the vast majority of people with diabetes don't know about their very high risk of cardiovascular disease.


