May 27, 1927 - November 11, 1999

Dr. Arvin was a board-certified family practice physician who served his entire medical career in Mount Vernon. He served as Rockcastle Hospital's chief of staff, the local Medical Society's president and on the Rockcastle County Health Department and Hospice board. He devoted many additional hours to delivering babies and emergency room coverage.

A graduate of Eastern Kentucky University and the University of Kentucky's College of Medicine, Dr.

Arvin received the obstetrics/gynecology award. He was a Louisville native and a Korean War veteran. Dr. Arvin found great satisfaction in serving others and in travel. He was active in international medical mission work, serving in Brazil, Barbados, Russia, and Tanzania. In 1996, he realized a lifelong goal of piloting his plane trans-Atlantic to Moscow where he delivered supplies and

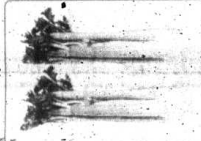
