Calendar Year 2012 Internal Revenue Code section 6041(a) and section 6041A(a) state that reportable payments made to any recipient of the payments during a calendar year totaling less than \$600 are not required to be issued IRS Form 1099-G or IRS Form 1099-MISC.

This rule does not apply if withholding was withheld from payments. If voluntary withholding or backup (involuntary) withholding was withheld and payments were less than \$600, then IRS Form 1099-G or IRS Form 1099-MISC will be

Beginning with calendar year 2012 IRS reporting, Kansas City will not generate and mail IRS Form 1099-G and/or IRS Form 1099-MISC to producers if the total of reportable payments for each tax identification number is less than

However, if voluntary withholding or backup (involuntary) withholding was withheld from a payment and total payments are less than \$600, then the appropriate IRS 1099 form will be issued.

Beginning with calendar year 2012 IRS reporting, Kansas City will also be issuing one IRS Form 1099-G and/or one IRS Form nity provider and employer.

1099-MISC to each multicounty producer whose total reportable payments for each tax identification number are equal to or greater than \$600.

Multi-county producer IRS forms will use the producer's mailing address associated with the lowest State number and then the lowest county number within that State identified as receiving payments for the reportable calendar year. The Kansas City address will be used as the return address on the IRS forms.
