from Tallinn, Estonia. We're playing mostly traditional bluegrass, including the melodic, acoustic-country part of it. Included are there several gospel melodies, hymns and spirituals, some bluegrass-swing and a few traditional old-timey pieces.

Depending on the audience we usually have two thematic divisions: Traditional American Bluegrass and Gospel or Gospel songs and hymns in Estonian, using, however, the same instrumentation and bluegrass instruments and having the same traditional bluegrass/ country sound as a result. We don't have newgrass or modern bluegrass sound. And by the way, since the roots of Estonian modern folky music are deep in German tradition even the basic melodies turn out to be quite similar as played on bluegrass instruments.

Through these years of our existence we have played in churches and at Christian events, in public houses and at some gospel-, country-, bluegrass or other festivals. Mostly in homeland Estonia, but also frequently in Finland, several trips and tours to Scandinavian Countries and some to Central Europe, including European\_World\_Of\_Bluegrass Festival 2001, 2002, 2004 and 2006 in Voorthuizen,NL and 2002 in Kolin,CZ and 2007 in SouthEastern FRANCE, La Roche sur Foron. 


