


TOILET PAPER DRIVE DEADLINE OCTOBER 24TH

Better Things Are Ahead By Howard Coop

It was the middle of September in 1946, and I was just out of high school. With high hopes and lofty aspirations, I had planned to go to the college of my choice that fall to pepare for the career I had chosen, but that possibility seemed to vanish. I was so disappointed that I gave up all hopesof achieving my lofty

The summer job that had promised so much and I had accepted so readily was a total failure; I had borrowed money to get through the summer. Therefore, there was no money and no hope for college, and I saw no possibility of achieving my goal. In that state of disappointment, I was frustrated, for I did not know what was ahead for me, but things changed amazingly fast.

On a beautiful Monday, September 16th, my father, with a few encouraging words, gave me some good advice that made all the difference in my life. Accepting his advice, I boarded a bus on Wednesday, September 18th, for Hopkinsville attend the LouisvilleAnnual Conference of our church. By the

end of that conference, I was appointed to serve as student pastor of three small churches near Lindsey Wilson College, and with the encouragement of some friends and \$1.58 in my pocket, I enrolled in college on my way home from that conference. The next few years were not always easy, but after some set backs, I graduated from college seven years later and went on to Emory University for further edu-

Life doesn't always give one what one wants. Along the way there are set backs--- and they are unpleasant. But those set backs are not the end of everything. One can't give up because of them, for better things are ahead. Some anonymous person put it in perspective: "Giving up on your goal because of one set back is like slashing your other tires because you have a flat." One must accept the set backs and move on.
